

# PICKLEBALL

### Crown Colony Pickleball Courts Open Daily 7 AM- 11 PM

• Reserve courts by calling the Pro Shop - 936 637 8800.

• Non-marking tennis or court shoes are required. Crocs, sandals, socked feet or bare feet are not allowed on the pickleball courts.

•Guests MUST accompany a member. Guest fee will be \$10 per day. Guest fees will be billed to the member's club account.

• Individual reservations may not exceed two hour increments per member. If courts are not full a member may continue to play but if the court they are playing is reserved they must move to a vacant court.

- Court's reserved for league play will have precedence over individual play.
- Proper clothing attired required. Shirts/blouses must be worn at all times.
- No swearing, arguments or intimidating threats.
- Deposit your trash in trash cans outside the courts.
- No spitting on the courts.
- No glass containers permitted on the courts.
- Smoking is not permitted on or around the courts.
- No play allowed when standing water is on the courts.
- No sitting or bouncing on the nets.
- Only pickleball play allowed on the pickleball courts.
- No animals, bikes, scooters, skateboards, skates, or rollerblades on the courts.
- Unsupervised use of the courts by players under the age of 12 is prohibited.

• Use courts at your own risk. Please report any incidents to Management or the Pro Shop.

• This area may be unsupervised at times, appropriate use of the courts is required.


